

























### GDP Declined in Q1 and Q2 of 2022, and Forecasters Expect a Similar Decline through the Middle of 2023






## TN Real GDP Growth, 2021






### State GDP Growth Rates, 2007 to 2021






















## U.S. Consumer Price Index Growth Rate



## Long Term U.S. Consumer Price Index Growth Rate





## WTI Spot Price in U.S. Dollars (Per Barrel)









### Tennessee Employment has Fully Recovered from the Pandemic






## **Tennessee New Entity Initial Filings**






## Tennessee Private Employment as Share of Pre-Pandemic Peak

September 2022 Employment as a share of February 2020 Employment






## Long Term Employment Growth Differs Dramatically Across Tennessee (Growth Since Great Recession)






## Tennessee and U.S. Job Opening Rate



## TN Unemployment Rate Below the U.S.




## Tennessee and U.S. Unemployed Persons Per Job Opening



Unemployed persons per job opening in TN




#### Tennessee and U.S. Hire Rate (as a Share of Employment)






## Tennessee and U.S. Total Separations Rate

(as a Share of Employment)






#### Tennessee and U.S. Quit Rate (as Share of Employment)






#### Labor Force Participation Has Not Recovered from the Pandemic




## Birth Rates have Fallen in the U.S.





## Average Hourly Earnings for TN, U.S.






## Wages are Growing Much Faster among the Lower Wage Part of the Market (Percent Annual Wage Growth)


#### Personal Income Growth Q2 2021 - Q2 2022


# Labor Productivity Growth, 2021





### **Tennessee House Price Index**




# **Tennessee's Housing Market is Tight**


#### Realty Transfer and Mortgage Tax Collections (3-Month Moving Average)

#### New TN Building Permits for Private Housing Units Monthly, Seasonally Adjusted


